Activities & Promotions- Has been contacting places about the banquet, have not set a date yet, tentatively January 14th. Indian Pueblo Cultural Center and El Pinto are going to be around \$35-40 per person. Haven't heard from Tanoan or Sadie's yet. Haven't heard back from Kanella about The Range. Will contact El Patron and Four Hills.

Recognized Shows- Still have dates for next year for Zia and Chamisa, there will be increases in facility costs. Show Secretary has officially resigned. Ringside productions does our premium prep, and they also have Main Ring productions. Will explore their availability, and they also manage dressage times. Evelyn Huff is also interested in working with our club. Need to look into booking professional horse show photographers and announcers for our bigger shows.

State Fair: We are acting as Sponsors and not hosts. We have provided the Fair with the tools to put on the show. We do have 10k in payback and AHANM will receive \$10 per horse per class out of entry fees. Ashley suggested that we have a flag presentation.

Competitive Distance- "I have not made additional contacts regarding Competitive Distance, but I will be attending the AHA (and other breed) Championship Ride in Idaho the end of September, serving as Ride Steward. If there are riders from Region 8, which I suspect there will be, I will make contact and get their input on possible locations, etc. for a Region 8 ride in 2023. There may not be enough distance riders in New Mexico to warrant holding an AHANM-sponsored ride, but we could work with other Region 8 people if there is interest in a Regional Ride, or in providing awards, or something else to help out. We'll see where this goes."


