Zia Classic and Region 8 Sport Horse Championships are quickly approaching with lots of entries rolling in! Entries close May 10th for all dressage and western dressage, including the regional classes. We will not be adding times after the closing date. Even if you are not qualified yet, but showing at Zia, please make those pre entries to ensure you get a ride time.

We anticipate filling all times after the success at Chamisa and growing excitement for the show season. The support from sponsors has been very strong from businesses to individuals to build the jackpots, prizes and facilitate the shows we have for the year. Another major milestone in our development of the horse community through shows is the collaborations we have growing, many which are focused on the Chile Roast September 8-10 at Hipico. Our event will be a diverse and audience centered display of the many ways we all enjoy our equine partners. The foundational Arabian show and class divisions are integrated among demonstrations with vaulting, driving, coon jumping, working equitation, in-hand jumping jackpot and NNMHA clinics geared towards new people to the industry and youth interaction with horses.

The hunter/jumper schedule has been expanded to 2 full show days and a full warm-up day with support and input from the hunter community. Both western and classical dressage have their own full days of ring time at Chile Roast with promotion and support from both NMDA and DCNM.

Other breeds in sponsorship and promotional positions include the Buckskins, AQHA, Appaloosas, Driving society, Minis, Mules and donkeys. Zia Working Equitation will be holding a 2-day clinic at the event in it's own arena space which is great for spectators as well as exhibitors to see a cool new way to embrace a hybrid of dressage, obstacles and timed events.

We have invited the 4H horse show to join us for that Saturday as well and would be a great demonstration of youth and horses. We are inviting vendors and food vendors to inquire about coming to the event to make the experience a full equine destination in September with no parking fees and a beautiful facility. Special buckles are in the works to share with high point winners in many divisions and the goal of \$10,000 in straight payback to exhibitors is in our sights.

We are still looking for a few more supporters from local business levels who would like to have the major reach this event will produce to not only current exhibitors, but all the new people we will reach through marketing efforts and promotion throughout the state. We have an army of amazing volunteers and board members who have put lots of time into building the event of the season this fall. If you build it, they will come! 
