Reyer Youth Scholarships Awarded at Summer Social NNMHA was pleased to announce at our summer social the awarding of the first annual Eldon and Karen Reyer Youth Scholarships to two worthy young people. While it was originally planned to award only one annual award, we decided there were two candidates that had such great credentials.



This scholarship supports anyone under the age of 22 pursuing equine- or agriculture-related higher education. These first-time scholarships support the nonprofit organization's goal to assist youth who are interested in pursuing higher education in equine or agricultural careers.

Recipient Savannah McSween (second from left in photo) joined 4-H at the age of seven where she eventually held several leadership positions. She also was Sandoval County Horse Council President. She graduated from Cibola High School and interned at Corrales Vet Clinic. McSween will attend New Mexico State University to major in Animal Science with plans to become a veterinarian.

Emily Adams, also a recipient, became involved with horses when she was six years old and currently works at Mariah Wilson's Platinum Performance Horses, Albuquerque. Emily graduated from Highland High School and Central New Mexico Community College, the latter at which she completed the Veterinary Technology program. Adams will attend Montana State University this fall and plans to become a large animal veterinarian.

Emily could not attend the social, as she was already at Montana State University attending orientation. Both Adams and McSween are Albuquerque residents.



#### Working Equitation Clinic


Chile Roast at HIPICO September 9-10, 2023 esented by the Arabian Horse Association of New Mexico and Zia Working Equitation Club



Lidia Taylor is a USA Working

Equitation licensed "r" judge and Technical Delegate. She has been teaching for 3 decades focusing on rider

exercises to address training issues, having studied the all important basics under Mr. Karl Mikolka, former Chief Rider of the Spanish Riding School of Vienna. Lidia is certified by the American Riding Instructor's Association as Level II Dressage, Driving, and Recreational Riding and Level III Western Dressage instructor and is a proud graduate of the Western Dressage Association of



America's Train the Trainer program.

#### What Is Working Equitation?

Working Equitation is a competitive sport that showcases classical horsemanship applied for livestock management. The sport originated in Europe, and consists of four trials. Dressage, Ease of Handling, Speed and Cattle trials are completed to test the training and partnership of each horse and rider team. Competitions are open to all breeds (including mules, donkeys and gaited horses), and all styles of riding. Dressage consists of

> completing a prescribed pattern of movements judged on a scale of o-10. Ease of Handling consists of completing an obstacle course with balance and precision. Each obstacle is scored on a scale of o-10.





#### Clinic Details:

The clinic will consist of two days of instruction with both unmounted lecture/instruction and mounted group instruction. All disciplines and all breeds are welcome! Participants new to the sport will learn the basics of the sport of Working Equitation as they receive instruction in Dressage and Ease of Handling. Riders with experience in working equitation will have the opportunity to fine tune skills with more advanced instruction.




