Director Reports

Membership- scheduled paint night with Kelly Jo Wine by Design on April 3rd. \$38 per person, and they will donate 25% of class proceeds and liquor sales back to the club. Minimum of 20 people will need to attend. Also planning an event for the fall. Newsletter- not present, nothing to report

Activities & Promotions- Tammy- Banquet update, had to change venue due to attendance being larger than we anticipated. 165 people attended. Cost \$8,475. Collected \$4,075. Auction brought in \$3,042. AHANM covered the remainder as previously decided, totaling approximately \$8.25 per person. Will consider securing a block of rooms for next year if venue is at a hotel.

Ashley- Budget \$5,530, spent \$5,214. Saddles were about \$1000 each. For legion of Honor awards, \$710 on blankets and halters. Board awards were donated by Ashley. Gift bags were donated by Mariah. New High Point Eligibility Rules are up on the website.

Recognized Shows- State Fair update – Mariah provided an update, still working on getting paybacks and club paid.

2023 Show progress- Update provided by Laura. Discussed contract rates for Chamisa for show manager, secretary, announcer, dressage coordinator, jump coordinator, and paddock manager. Equine Affair Aug 19-20 weekend @ Hipico-expanded to multiple breeds, payback goals

Competitive Distance- not present, provided email report. Would like to make a 3x6 banner to be displayed at Distance Horse National Championships next fall. Would also like to present awards at endurance rides held in NM. Submitted budget request for \$500 to cover banner and 24 awards for highest finishing A/HA.

Futurity- nothing to report, would like to consider most a "most improved rider" award and a "sportsmanship" award for youth at the end of the year.




