AHANM President Mariah Wilson has named Dana Mosher, Barb Clark, and Jessica Jones to the Nominating Committee. Dana will chair the Committee.

Distance Report

I was the AHA Ride Steward at the AHA Distance Horse National Championships held at the Huntersville Hundred site near Menahga, Minnesota. Arabians and Half-Arabians were dominant in the rides they entered. Those included AHA and Open 100 mile Endurance, AHA and Open 50 mile Endurance, AHA and Open 40 mile Competitive Trail, AHA and Open Limited Distance, and a Limited Distance Challenge (3) consecutive days). In addition to Arabian/Half-Arabian Championships, there were Championships offered for Appaloosas, Morgans, Paso Finos, Performance Shagya Arabians, Saddlebreds, and Akal Tekes. AERC rules were followed for Endurance, and AHA rules were followed for Competitive Trail. The ride site was beautiful, Ride Camp was in a very large pasture and 80+ rigs were parked there, trails were well marked and well maintained, and there were no serious problems. Next year's DHNC will be held August 23-25 at the Iron Mountain Jubilee, Cripple Creek, Virginia.
